## 2018 Norwegian Explorers Christmas Annual and Sigerson Awards

The Norwegian Explorers of Minnesota publishes a Christmas Annual which has gained international recognition within the Sherlockian community. This publication is distributed each year to attendees of our annual dinner in December as well as to those attending the Baker Street Irregulars Annual Dinner and the Gaslight Gala during the Sherlock Holmes Birthday weekend in New York. The Sigerson Awards, our light-hearted recognition for contributors, will also be presented at the Norwegian Explorers' annual dinner. Every year our members are challenged to submit original works based on a topic we hope will inspire their creativity. This year we ask you to consider:

## WAR AND PEACE

Although best known as a monumental novel by Leo Tolstoy, "War and Peace" is now also the theme of the 2018 *Norwegian Explorers Christmas Annual*. References and allusions to war and peace can be found across the entire Canon, providing much material that contributors might develop based around this theme. Within the first paragraph written by Watson, he mentioned his experiences in the second Afghan war, and toward the end of the Canon, Holmes went undercover to thwart a German spy. In other stories Holmes helped to prevent war, and his actions can frequently be seen as maintaining the peace! Numerous other canonical characters have had noteworthy war-related or peacetime experiences that should not be overlooked. With 2018 being the 100th anniversary of the end of World War One, we felt that this would be an appropriate theme to inspire our members' creativity.

Contributors are encouraged to explore a wide range of ideas dealing with this topic. These could involve how Holmes prevented a war (or wars), how Watson adjusted to peacetime life, how war affected other characters, or even how particular characters might have waged their own private wars with one other. There is much that could fit our "war and peace" theme, but we will also consider submissions that fall outside of the topic.

- 6. Contributors with submissions published in our Christmas Annual will continue to retain all rights to have their work published elsewhere.

- 9. Judges for the Sigerson Awards will be selected by the Norwegian Explorers. Decisions of the judges are final.
